

RESOLUTION NO. 17-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE STATE LEGISLATURE'S EFFORTS TO AMEND SECTION 403.7033, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO PROVIDE FOR LOCAL REGULATION OF RETAIL PLASTIC BAGS OR, ALTERNATIVELY, FOR THE REPEAL OF SAID STATUTORY SECTION SO THAT LOCAL GOVERNMENTS ARE NO LONGER PREEMPTED FROM ENACTING LEGISLATION REGULATING RETAIL PLASTIC BAGS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is diligent in its efforts to preserve the beautiful environment that supports the tourism industry which is so vital to the economy of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Broward County, and the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, retail plastic bags are detrimental because they do not fully degrade in our oceans or land environment and they introduce unsafe chemicals into our environment; and

WHEREAS, retail plastic bags create the potential for death of land and marine animals through entanglement and ingestion; and

WHEREAS, the expansive usage of single-use retail shopping bags and their typical disposal rates creates an impediment to the City's waste reduction and recycling goals while creating unsightly litter; and

WHEREAS, single-use retail plastic bags are difficult to recycle and frequently contaminate material that is processed through the City's recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, replacing single-use retail bags with reusable bags is considered a quick and easy way to reduce waste and litter, protect wildlife and conserve resources; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission acknowledges that some businesses have taken affirmative steps to accomplish this goal and recognizes their proactive efforts; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best public interest for the Florida Legislature to provide for the local regulation of single-use retail shopping bags;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby declares its support of an amendment to Section 403.7033, *Florida Statutes*, which amendment would provide for local regulation of retail plastic bags under the State's proposed guidelines.

SECTION 2. Alternatively, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, requests that the Florida Legislature repeal Section 403.7033, *Florida Statutes*, so that local governments may enact and enforce legislation regarding the use and disposal of retail plastic bags.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
