TITLE:	Resolution Granting a Waiver of Limitations at 353 & 363 Sunset Drive for the installation of fourteen (14) mooring piles

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations for the installation of fourteen (14) mooring piles.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow mooring piles to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Section 47-19.3 (D) the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for the installation of fourteen (14) mooring piles extending a maximum of +/- 54.9 feet from the property line into the adjacent Sunset Lake. Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required. The applicant's narrative specifies that the additional distance for these mooring piles is necessary to safely moor neighbor's vessels, especially during high wind events and severe weather.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended approval of the application 9 to 4 (see Exhibit 3).

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$300.
