TITLE: Motion to Accept State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Funds and

to Award the SHIP funds to New Visions Community Development

Corporation for Housing Counseling Services

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission accept the additional 2016-2017 State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) funds in the amount of \$24,842 for Housing Counseling; approve an award of \$22,357.80 of these funds to New Visions Community Development Corporation (New Visions) with the remaining 10% to be used for administrative costs; and authorize the City Manager to execute all documents associated with the acceptance of this allocation and the award request.

# **Background**

In 2013, the Legislative Budget Commission approved a \$10 million allocation from the National Mortgage Settlement Funds to provide foreclosure counseling services to be administered by Florida Housing Finance Corporation (FHFC) through the Foreclosure Counseling Program (FCP). The 2016 housing bill allows FHFC to expand the types of counseling that can be provided to homeowners and prospective homebuyers to include other counseling and financial coaching.

The FHFC is making funding available from the FCP SHIP funds to provide housing counseling. The City has received \$24,842.00 of which \$22,357.80 will be used for services and \$2,484.20 will be used for administration. These funds will be considered 2016-2017 SHIP funds and reported as housing counseling.

This funding may not be used for counseling activities such as homeowner training related to rehabilitation but for housing counseling related to homeownership. The funding may be used to carry out the following objectives:

- Help prevent homeowners from going into foreclosure
- Provide at-risk homeowners with financial management education to assist them with credit problems to become financially stable.

A Housing Counseling Request for Proposal (RFP) was sent to the four non-profit agencies that currently administer the City's Purchase Assistance Program. Responses were received from three of the agencies on March 6, 2017. These Proposals were reviewed by the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC) and a recommendation was made at their March 13, 2017 meeting. New Visions was voted by AHAC to receive the award.

New Visions will provide post-purchase counseling, housing consumer education and anti-predatory lending counseling for homeowners.

### **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact of \$22,357 SHIP funds given to New Visions for Housing Counseling Services plus administrative costs of \$2,484.
