TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for Elevator Maintenance and Repairs –

Maverick United Elevator LLC - \$253,748

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a one-year contract award, in substantially the form attached, with Maverick United Elevator LLC (Maverick) for elevator maintenance and repairs in the estimated amount of \$253,748; and authorize the City Manager to approve three, one-year renewal options contingent upon appropriation of funds.

## **Background**

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting approval to purchase elevator maintenance and repair services for City-wide facilities. The locations include City Hall, Aquatic Complex, War Memorial Auditorium, Parking Services building, Police station, Public Works buildings and Fire-Rescue stations. Contract prices include furnishing all labor, tools, equipment, materials and supplies to provide full maintenance service, including all inspections, adjustments, tests, parts or component replacements, and repairs to keep the elevator in continuous use at their established capacity and efficiency and for their intended purpose.

Invitation to Bid No. 373-11883 was opened on March 16, 2017 and three bids were received. Maverick is deemed to be the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

#### **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$78,600 for FY 2017 operating budget in the accounts listed below. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of funds.
