**TITLE**: Motion to Approve Contract for South Ocean Bridge Drive Project – Lakes

Engineering, Inc. - \$600,000 (two-year total)

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a two-year contract for design and construction engineering services, in substantially the form attached, with Lakes Engineering, Inc. for the South Ocean Bridge Drive Project in the estimated amount of \$600,000; and authorize the City Manager to approve two one-year renewal options, contingent on appropriation of funds.

### **Background**

On January 18, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Request for Qualifications No. 471-11891 for the South Ocean Bridge Drive Project. On April 19, 2017, the City Commission approved negotiations with the top ranked firm, Lakes Engineering, Inc. (CAM 17-0455). Negotiation with Lakes Engineering, Inc. was successful and is therefore included in this approval request.

The selected firm will provide design and construction engineering services under this contract as authorized by individual task orders for individual project tasks. It is the intent of the City to use this firm for the entire South Ocean Bridge replacement project.

#### **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$600,000. Funds for this contract in the amount of \$600,000 are available in the FY 2017 Community Investment Plan in account listed below:
