TITLE:	Motion to Approve Contract for Americans with Disabilities Act Improvements for City Hall – PE-Services "L.L.C." - \$421,186

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract, in substantially the form attached, to PE-Services "L.L.C." for the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Improvements Project for City Hall in the amount of \$421,186.

Background

On September 24, 2013, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development notified the City of non-compliance issues related to ADA accessibility at City Hall. The purpose of this project is to address ADA compliance issues involving the pedestrian access routes from the parking lot into City Hall, ADA accessibility within the City Hall 1st and 8th floor bathrooms, and accessibility to the Commission Chamber.

On March 27, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 673-11912. Five bids were received on April 27, 2017. Bids submitted by the five bidders were reviewed for compliance with the specifications of the solicitation. The bid submitted by PE-Services "L.L.C." has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder recommended for award.

ADA improvements are appropriate uses of Community Development Block Grant program funds in City Hall due to the building's location in a low to moderate income area.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$421,186 for the contract award and \$42,500 for estimated in-house project management fees for a total cost of \$463,686. Funds for this purchase are available in the FY 2017 Community Investment Plan and Community Development Block Grant in the accounts listed below.
