TITLE:	Motion to Approve Purchase of Additional Licenses and Associated Professional Services for the Deployment of the Enterprise Content Management System (Laserfiche) – MCCI, LLC – \$31,296

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of required licenses and associated professional services for the deployment of the Enterprise Content Management System (Laserfiche) for the Human Resources Department from MCCI, LLC in the amount of \$31,296.

Background

On February 17, 2015, the City Commission approved a contract for the purchase of Laserfiche from MCCI, LLC including funding for the initial task order for the deployment of the software and migration of electronic documents for the Department of Sustainable Development (CAM 15-0251).

The City is prioritizing the departments that still store electronic documents in the legacy system and as such, a second task order has been created for the deployment of Laserfiche and migration of existing electronic documents from the legacy system for the Human Resources Department.

The cost breakdown is as follows:
