TITLE:	Motion to Approve Contract for Abandonment of Wells at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport – Gemstone Builders LLC - \$226,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, with Gemstone Builders LLC for the abandonment of water supply wells located at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) property and its vicinity in the amount of \$226,000.

Background

Due to regulatory monitoring and compliance requirements by the South Florida Water Management District and Broward County Department of Environmental Protection, the City of Fort Lauderdale has to properly abandon six wells at the FXE property and its vicinity. Abandoning a well must be done via a construction project with a construction permit in accordance with all regulatory requirements.

On May 15, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid Number 673-11952. Four bids were received on June 14, 2017. All bids received were reviewed for compliance with the specifications of the bid. Gemstone Builders LLC was deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder recommended for award.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$226,000 for construction and \$38,000 for estimated in-house project management fees or a total of \$264,000. Funds for this contract in the amount of \$264,000 are available in the FY 2017 Community Investment Plan in the account listed below with \$121,000 contingent upon the approval of the consolidated budget amendment, CAM 17-0751.
