TITLE: Resolution Authorizing the Acceptance of Grant Funds and Execution of a

Grant Agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration for Construction of Taxiway Foxtrot Pavement Rehabilitation Project at Fort Lauderdale

Executive Airport

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution accepting the anticipated grant funding of \$2,250,905 or 90% of the costs, whichever is less, for the construction costs for the Taxiway Foxtrot Pavement Rehabilitation project at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and authorize the City Manager to execute a Grant Agreement, contingent upon review and approval by the City Attorney, on behalf of the City for such funding.

Background

As part of the ongoing Statewide Airfield Pavement Management Program, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) performed a review of the FXE runway and taxiway pavements, and issued a report with its findings in June of 2015. The review determined that a portion of Taxiway Foxtrot, which is west of Taxiway Golf (Exhibit 1) has a Pavement Condition Index (PCI) value of 59.

FDOT recommends a minimum service level PCI of 65 for parallel taxiways. The minimum service level is recommended to ensure the pavement provides a safe operational surface and efficiently uses maintenance and rehabilitation budgets. In addition, the geometry of intersections adjacent to Taxiway Foxtrot are non-compliant with the current Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) design standards and will be corrected during this project.

Construction plans and specifications have been developed to address the above conditions. The project was advertised and a low-bid was submitted in the amount of \$2,138,102. Inspection and administrative services costs are estimated to be \$362,904 for a total project cost of \$2,501,006. We have submitted a grant application to the FAA for acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$2,250,905 or 90% of the anticipated costs. In an effort to expedite the execution of the grant agreement, airport staff is requesting to

appropriate the anticipated grant funds and accept the grant contingent upon the City Attorney's review prior to execution of the agreement. If the grant is not awarded, the related expenditures will be charged to the Airport Fund.

At its meeting of July 27, 2017 the Aviation Advisory Board supported staff's recommendation to accept the grant from the FAA.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City for the grant in the amount of \$2,250,905. The required grant match of \$250,101 is currently funded in the Community Investment Plan and is contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the August 22, 2017 Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM #17-0841.
