- TITLE: Motion to Approve Purchase of Roadway and Swale Maintenance Equipment and Sale of Replaced Assets – Clark Equipment Company d/b/a Bobcat Company - \$109,490.82

# **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of roadway and swale maintenance equipment and proprietary options via State of Florida Contract #22101000-15-1 from Clark Equipment Company d/b/a Bobcat Company in the amount of \$109,490.82 and approve the sale of all replaced assets.

# **Background**

The items to be replaced consist of two pieces of road maintenance equipment used by the Public Works Department for maintenance of the swales, alleyways and roadways. The equipment consists of two Bobcat A770 All-Wheel Steer Loader machines, both of which meet the criteria for replacement. The criteria used to determine when to replace a vehicle includes the following:

- Age and mileage (hours) of vehicle
- Type of service for which the vehicle is used
- Reliability over time as the vehicle has aged
- Operating and maintenance costs.

The City will sell the replaced assets listed in Exhibits 4 and 5 utilizing the current approved auctioneer services.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(7), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, this purchase will be made in accordance with the State of Florida Contract No. 22101000-15-1 from Clark Equipment Company, whereby such contract or formal bid followed formal bid procedures of sealed written bids, public opening, and legal advertising.

Pursuant to Section 2-189, Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the City may purchase proprietary items, as defined in Section 2-173, without the necessity of public bids. As defined by the Code, a proprietary item is not readily available from more than one supplier, manufacturer, or person and is unique in nature. Options in the amount of \$98 are not included in the options listed in the State of Florida

Contract 22101000-15-1, but must be provided at the time of manufacture from the stated manufacturer, and are therefore deemed proprietary.

# Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$109,490.82. Funds for this purchase in the amount of \$109,490.82 are available in the FY 2017 Budget in the account listed below:
