TITLE: Motion Approving a Revocable License Agreement with Autonation, Inc.

for the Construction of a Temporary Beach Statue

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion to authorize execution of a Revocable License with Autonation, Inc., in substantially the form attached, for the construction of a temporary beach statue at Las Olas Boulevard and A1A.

Background

Autonation, Inc. has requested to construct a temporary beach statue in the shape of a pink ribbon, see Exhibit 1, during the month of October, to raise awareness for Breast Cancer.
