TITLE: Motion to Approve the 2017-2018 State Housing Initiatives Partnership

(SHIP) Funds and Amend the 2016-2017 SHIP Program Income

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve accepting the 2017-2018 State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program funds in the amount of \$752,930; permit staff to use up to 10% of SHIP Funds for administrative costs; and as program income is earned, up to 5% be set aside for administrative costs. Revisions are being proposed to the 2016-2017 SHIP Funds to pay the cost of home repairs for eligible homeowners; and that the City Manager is authorized to execute all documents related to the acceptance of this allocation.

Background

The SHIP Program administered by Florida Housing Finance Corporation (FHFC) has been appropriated \$94,225,000 in funding for the 2017-2018 fiscal year. The City of Fort Lauderdale will receive \$752,930 to be used for affordable housing strategies per the approved 2016-2019 Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP), CAM #16-0253. The estimated program income will be \$70,000 and program interest is estimated to be \$7,000.

Funding requirements are as follows:

- A minimum of 20% of allocated SHIP funds are to be used to serve special needs persons with a priority to serve persons with developmental disabilities as defined in section 420.004, Florida Statutes.
- There is no required funding certification form for 2017-2018.

Funding allocations are recommended for the following programs for the 2017-2018 fiscal year:

- 1. Owners Occupied Rehabilitation \$527,051.
- 2. Special Needs \$150,586.
- 3. Administration \$75,293.

Resource Impact

Funding for this item is contingent upon the approval of the September 19, 2017 consolidated budget amendment CAM #17-1116.
