## **RESOLUTION NO. 17-162**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) ALLOWING TEMPORARY ACCESS TO THE CITY OWNED PROPERTY AT 2801 SW 4<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE – FIRE STATION 3; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation proposes to construct the signalization of existing 4-way stop controlled intersection on City Road No. SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 28<sup>th</sup> Street, Item/Segment No.4378661, in Broward County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that certain lands now owned by the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, be used temporarily by the State of Florida for the use and benefit of the State of Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, said use is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has made application to said City to execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation a license agreement or agreements, in favor of the State of Florida, for the purpose of installing a pre-emption button (traffic control device for the Fire Department) inside the Fire Station including the right to access, ingress and egress, and such other rights that are necessary and incidental to said installation, and said request having been duly considered;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

- <u>SECTION 1</u>. That the Recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.
- <u>SECTION 2</u>. That the application of the State of Florida Department of Transportation for a license agreement or agreements are for transportation purposes which are in the public or community interest for public welfare.
- <u>SECTION 3</u>. That a license agreement or agreements in favor of the State of Florida, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, should be executed by the property City Officials. Consideration shall be \$ZERO.
