TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for the A-13 Sewer Redirection - East of
Federal Highway – C & W Pipeline, Inc., \$2,298,086

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract, in substantially the form attached, to C & W Pipeline, Inc. for the A-13 Sewer Redirection - East of Federal Highway Project in the amount of \$ 2,298,086.

Background

The existing A-7 pump station serving the downtown development area is currently at capacity necessitating the construction of the new pump station, A-13, east of Federal Highway. The new pump station will provide an additional one million gallons per day capacity (1 MGD) and allow for future development. The project will consist of a new gravity sewer, a new force main, and a new submersible triplex sewage pump station and valve vault.

On June 14, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid Number 473-11979. Eight bids were received on July 17, 2017. All proposals were reviewed for compliance with the specifications of the bid. The proposal submitted by C & W Pipeline, Inc. was deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder recommended for award. Their bid in the amount of \$2,298,086 includes applicable allowances and alternate bid item #40.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$2,298,086 for construction and \$360,000 for estimated in-house project management fees, or a total of \$2,658,086. Funds for this contract, in the amount of \$2,658,086, will be available in the FY 2018 Community Investment Plan in the account listed below:
