- TITLE: Amending Resolution No. 17-95 to correct the Sketch and Legal included in Exhibit "A" for the Utility Easement Vacation for the Property located at 2201 W. Broward Boulevard

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission amend adopted Resolution No. 17-095 to correct the exhibit vacating the utility easement at 2201 W. Broward Boulevard.

Background

On May 2, 2017, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 17-95 (Exhibit 1) vacating the existing water and sewer utility easement. After Resolution 17-95 passed it was determined that the attached Exhibit "A" did not include the correct sketch and legal for the utility easement to be vacated.

The vacation request would allow the applicant to vacate and relocate the existing 8-inch water main and 8-inch sanitary sewer. The applicant will relocate the utilities according to the approved Site Plan Level III (Planning and Zoning Board) application approved by the Planning and Zoning Board on March 15, 2017 for the Riverbend Broward self-storage and warehouse project.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
