Chair Seiler recognized Count Rosenthal, 1237 NW 4th Avenue, who spoke in support of this item, stating this would be an improvement for the area. The contractor is a well-respected firm who will conduct the project in an economic and professional manner.

Chair Seiler recognized Charles King, 105 N. Victoria Park Drive, who commented on this project at 315 East Sistrunk Boulevard.

Commissioner Rogers commented that Flagler Village is no longer slum and blight. He recommended prioritizing areas on Sistrunk Boulevard west of the railroad tracks. Commissioner Trantalis commented the Commission still has a responsibility to fund street improvements such as sidewalks and lighting in the City. These needs still exist in Flagler Village. This needs to be addressed on a case by case basis, agreeing that the need is greater west of the railroad tracks. Vice Chair Roberts concurred that these items need to be considered on a case by case basis. Commissioner Trantalis commented on the large amount of CRA funding for the YMCA. He commented that there are so many issues to address in the Northwest in addition to slum and blight, including housing, sidewalks, Park improvements, and Police protection. Perhaps this large CRA expenditure could have been better utilized by spreading those funds throughout the Northwest on a case by case basis. Commissioner Rogers commented on the importance of a fast start and a strategic location to ensure the YMCA's success. Further comments and discussions ensued on this item's expenditure in Flagler Village. Commissioner Trantalis noted the financial commitment of this item's beneficiary.

Commissioner McKinzie commented on upcoming CRA projects and what will be needed to meet necessary thresholds on a case by case basis on both the east and west sides of the railroad tracks. Further comments and discussions ensued on this topic.

Commissioner McKinzie made a motion to approve this item which was seconded by Commissioner Rogers.

Mayor Seiler recognized Count Rosenthal, 1237 NW 4th Avenue, who spoke in support of this item. Mr. Rosenthal stated these funds are for a good program to facilitate young entrepreneurs into the City. He expounded on the need for CRA programs to address issues related to economic status.

Mayor Seiler recognized Charles King, 105 N. Victoria Park Drive, who commented on this project and the ability for the applicant to move forward without the assistance of CRA funds.

Commissioner Trantalis commented that this is a profit making venture whose goal is to incubate local area entrepreneurs, noting this is the first one in the City. The applicant commented on this venture's uniqueness to Fort Lauderdale and his experience with other ventures. Discussions continued on CRA funding going toward capital improvements as opposed to product development, self-financing for other items and aspects of the culture in the area regarding startups. Further discussions ensued on the aspects of incubator development in other areas and the applicant's business plan.

Commissioner Trantalis made a motion to approve this item which was seconded by Commissioner Rogers.
