TITLE: Motion to Approve a Dockage Facility Use Agreement with Winterfest, Inc.
for the 2017 Winterfest Boat Parade

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion authorizing a Dockage Facility Use Agreement with Winterfest, Inc. for staging of the 2017 Winterfest Boat Parade on December 9, 2017, and execution of the agreement by the City Manager.

Background

This is a request for authorization to enter into a Dockage Facility Use Agreement with Winterfest, Inc. for payment of fees to the City in the amount of \$2,359.02 representing the loss of revenue resulting from the required vacation of vessel-occupied slips during the 2017 Winterfest Boat Parade. The fees are associated with the staging of vessels and spectator viewing on the New River and Riverwalk for the 2017 Winterfest Boat Parade.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$2,359.02.
