TITLE: Application for a Dock Permit for Use by a Private Person, Ann Fox, on
Public Property located at 827 SE 2nd Street

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution granting a dock permit for use by a private person, Ann Fox, on public property located at 827 SE 2nd Street.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property in accordance with Section 8-144 of the Code of Ordinances for the use, maintenance and repair of a proposed 18'2" long x 6'2" wide floating dock with a 6' long x 3' wide ramp adjacent to 827 SE 2nd Street.

The Marine Advisory Board (MAB) recommended approval of the application 10 to 0 (Exhibit 3). The November 2017 Marine Advisory Board Meeting was cancelled due to the boat show, therefore, draft minutes have been provided as backup for this memo.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a permit for usage by private persons of public property, an application fee in the amount of \$300 is required.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$300. Revenue related to this agreement is included in the FY2018 operating budget in the account listed below:
