TITLE:	Motion to Approve Proprietary Purchase of Annual Software Maintenance Service – Cogsdale Corporation - \$235,431

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the proprietary purchase of annual software maintenance service from Cogsdale Corporation in the amount of \$235,431.

Background

The Information Technology Services Department requires proprietary maintenance software/hardware support services for the Financial Accounting Management Information System (FAMIS) and Budget Preparation (BPREP) software. This software is used for financial accounting and budget preparation. There are over 500 users throughout the City who access this system and have numerous interfaces from other computer systems. This purchase is made via the City's existing evergreen agreement which renews every year until cancelled.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(f)(3), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the City may purchase proprietary items, as defined in Section 2-173, without competitive solicitation. As defined by the Code, a proprietary item is not readily available from more than one supplier, manufacturer, or person and is unique in nature, without competitive solicitation. Cogsdale Corporation is the sole provider of support for the FAMIS/BPREP system.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact in the amount of \$235,431.
