TITLE: Motion to Approve Increase in Expenditure to Contract for Plan Benefits -

Humana Dental Insurance Company - \$260,000 (estimated total)

## Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Commission approve an increase of expenditure to contract with Humana Dental Insurance Company (Humana) for dental plan benefits in the estimated amount of \$260,000 resulting in a new annual contract value of \$1,511,129.

## **Background**

On October 1, 2013, the City Commission approved a one-year contract (with three one-year renewals) for a fully insured dental plan with Humana that commenced on January 1, 2014 and will expire on December 31, 2017 (CAM #13-1237).

Dental premiums are calculated on a per subscriber rate and for 2017 a total dental plan premium amount of \$1,251,129 was estimated. Due to increased staffing levels and Humana exercising its contractual right to extend a 5% maximum rate cap increase to the dental plans, additional funding in the estimated amount of \$260,000 is requested to increase the contract value in 2017.

## **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$260,000 in FY 2018. Funds for this purchase are available in the FY 2018 budget in the below listed account.
