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Number of registered bidders in database; percentage of regular buyers; average number of website hits per month

Our bidder database currently has over 65,000 registered bidders. These are actual registered bidders who have provided information in our system including name, address, email, phone numbers and other personal information which allows us to distinguish individual bidders from one another. Our bidders are verified utilizing multiple online tools available which include, but are not limited to, address verification, phone verification and bidder verification via online payment services that we utilize.

The number of visitors to our site varies from month to month. Our server captures this information for us and we are able to access it via our private cPanel Login. This gives us data about our workspaces utilized for auctions including the geographic information of bidders/potential bidders visiting our site, peak times for bidding activity along with hourly, daily and monthly statistics for any portion of our site. We average 30 million hits per month on our website currently and this number has been consistently in this range for the past twelve months.

Process used to prevent fraud and shill bidding and details on how problems are addressed

Once a bidder registers on our site, they are required to put up a \$100.00 refundable deposit in order for their account to be activated. Bidders are able to submit this deposit via PayPal which allows us to verify the information they have registered with along with the information attached to their PayPal account. This is an extra layer of verification for us since most bidders have a credit card or bank account tied to their PayPal account so being able to verify the information they input in our system versus what they have in their PayPal account allows us to verify information and then question any information that does not match before a bidder is actually activated. The \$100.00 refundable deposit was put in place years ago at the request of one of our long time clients. In requiring that a potential bidder places a deposit before bidding will ensure that we are dealing with legitimate bidders. Since instituting the deposit requirement, our occurrences of non-pays and bad bids has decreased significantly. Anyone placing a bid on our site knows that they must honor the bid or they risk forfeiting the \$100.00 and being banned permanently from the site. The refundable deposit has been a very effective tool in preventing fraudulent or shill bidding. It also instills confidence in all bidders in that they know they are bidding against another legitimate bidder if they are bidding on our site.

Problems with bidders are handled on a case by case basis, depending on the actual nature of the problem and the history we have with the bidder. Below are examples of types of problems that can arise and how they are handled.

Bidding error - Even though we have safeguards in place to keep bidding errors from happening, the reality is that in a public auction, you are dealing with the public and mistakes will be made on occasion. It would be difficult for anyone to determine if a bidder's mistake was on purpose or truly a mistake but we utilize our bidder database to review these cases. Our system gives multiple warnings if a bidder is placing a bid incorrectly. It will warn of missing decimal points, incorrect next bid requirements, a bidder already being the high bidder, etc. Our system warns of the errors and in most cases will require the bidder to go back and re-enter a bid if it doesn't meet certain specifications. However, if a bidder is

placing a bid higher than they intended or they are bidding on the wrong lot, there is no system that can read a bidder's mind and keep them from making this type of bidding errors. Depending on when we are notified of the bidding error, we may or may not be able to correct it for the bidder. It all depends on how much time is left before the item closes and what the bid history is showing. In these cases, we look at our bidder's history with us and can determine if they have made bidding errors in the past or if it is a first time occurrence for them. In any case, we can correct these errors only if it does not negatively affect the price of the item and does not affect another bidder. We utilize a very specific process when reviewing a possible bid error and follow that process each time to determine what, if anything can be done for the bidder.

Bidder disputes a bid placed - We are able to view the IP address of all bids placed in our system. We then cross check this with the IP address that was utilized when the bidder registered with us as well as the IP address of other known legitimate bids that the bidder has placed through our site. Our system allows us to complete a thorough and accurate research of activity when answering and solving any problems or issues that arise with a bidder's claim of this type and made a decision accordingly.

Dispute Resolution - If a dispute arises on any of the agency's items, assisting with those issues is a critical part of our business model. RBAI is not simply a web host provider where you can post your items. Instead, we are a full service auction company that takes responsibility for your auction from start to finish. If a buyer defaults on a bid or disputes an item for any reason, we are there to assist the City in the resolution or handle the resolution entirely given the permission of the City to do so. When bidders default, RBAI will be the one to notify the City of such default. Since the collection of your auction proceeds is our responsibility, we will have made numerous phones and email contacts in the event a bidder does not pay. In this case, we will ban the bidder from any future participation in our auctions. We will also get with the City to determine if they want us to try and go to a backup bidder or if the City decides to do, we will handle it and as always, any items not paid for will never cost the City as we only collect on items sold and collected.

In the event of disputes, we will assist the City when requested. We can provide valuable information to the City on the bidder such as their bid history, record of any past disputes, timely or delinquent payment patterns, etc. We believe that each scenario is unique and each bidder is unique. We will always be happy to give the City advice in this area or handle the disputes with the City's permission. Before doing so, we always evaluate the past history of the bidder in question and give recommendations based on that along with other solutions that City's have used in the past for similar situations. Whatever the case, we will always be available to help resolve any issues as we want the City's auction process to be as smooth as possible.

We want to stress again that we are not simply providing a "web posting solution" for you. We consider ourselves a partner in your auction process and will be responsive to your issues as if they were our own.

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Additional information relevant in evaluating our bidder base

We believe that a good solid bidder base is the key to a successful auction for our clients. The more contact we have with our bidder base, the more we ensure that we will eliminate problems or issues before they arise. We have multiple ways of communicating with our bidder base.

Our principal means of notifying buyers is via email. Buyers are able to access all questions regarding our online auctions on <u>www.renebates.com</u>. Buyers register online, contact us online and bid online. When a buyer is participating in an online auction, they are emailed each time they have been outbid. They are sent email notifications on a weekly basis of all auctions that have been added to our website. We have a sophisticated bulk mailing system with multiple features that are utilized for contacting our buyer database and those potential buyers that have registered through our site. We are able to sort this list by Active Bidders, New Bidders, Active Subscribers, New Subscribers, Clients, Potential Clients and others. Our system tracks all emails sent through the system. We can view bulk emails sent at any given time and are able to see how many actually clicked into the email and visited our site as well as anyone who has subscribed today or this year as well as those who have unsubscribed today or this year. These lists may be updated and edited at any time and are always current up to the minute.

When a buyer is the successful bidder, they receive their invoice via email. When they have paid for their auction items, they receive a paid invoice via email. Initial follow-up is done with the bidders through email. This ensures that we have an audit record of all communications and notifications to the bidder.

Buyers are also able to contact us by telephone during our business hours. In addition, we consistently make phone contact with our bidders if a phone call is more appropriate depending on the type of question or problem that the bidder may have. If a buyer reaches the collection status, they are contacted by telephone as well as the emails that are sent by our office.

Service and support for the bidder/buyer is provided in whatever manner the buyer prefers. Our website is user friendly and offers help through its various links such as How to Bid, Frequently Asked Questions, Terms and Conditions and Forms menus. The Help menu on our home page explains all features on our website and how they work. Our Frequently Asked Questions section has been compiled from listening to our online bidders over the years. In addition, we have staff available Monday – Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM to assist bidders via the telephone or email, whichever method the buyer prefers.

RBAI has ample staff available to respond to customer service and technical issues. We are able to respond within 24 hours (which is our internal policy on such issues) Monday – Friday 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. It is our policy to answer all emails the same business day they are received or by the next business day for those requests sent to us after 5:00 PM on any given day. Our entire staff is fully trained in all website operations and can respond and resolve most issues in a very short period of time. At RBAI, we take customer service very seriously and do everything in our power to accommodate both our sellers and buyers in any way that we can.

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We also provide computer technical support available in the event a bidder is having any issues they can't resolve. We see this most frequently when there is a bidder that needs assistance on why their particular internet browser or operating system is functioning a certain way. This typically happens when bidders have older computers using older systems. Our computer personnel are able to help determine any problems and assist in educating the bidder on the ways that online auctions are "best viewed" according to industry standards.

Customer Satisfaction/Maintaining Good Customer Relations with Bidders

A core belief of our company is that we cannot be successful without good bidders and good sellers. As a result of this belief, we make every effort to accommodate both bidders and sellers. Good communication is one of the best ways to maintain good customer relations with our bidders. We offer multiple ways for a bidder to reach us. They are able to email any of our employees directly, they can email us through our website, and we are available by phone and also provide cell phone numbers to bidders if any of the officers are out and need to be reached. We encourage bidders to give us any and all feedback as it relates to our website, its functions, our processes and even our seller's. All customer feedback is given to upper management and we make personal contact with bidders as necessary. Each and every bidder is important to our company and we validate this belief by always being available for the bidder no matter what the problem or issue and no matter how large or small.

Payment Methods

RBAI accepts payment for auction purchases in the form of cash, cashier's check or money order within 4 days of the close of the auction. In addition, we are able to accept wire transfers upon request. For the \$100.00 refundable deposit only, we allow our bidders to send us money via Pay Pal. The use of Pay Pal for the payment of the \$100.00 refundable deposit allows bidders to remit these funds instantaneously. This is a convenience tool for the bidders who do not want to obtain and mail a cashier's check or money order and also accommodates those bidders that wait until the last minute to decide they want to bid. Pay Pal is a very quick and reliable way for bidders to remit their \$100.00 refundable deposit. We accept PayPal for auction purchases up to \$400 which allows bidders to use their credit cards. We place a cap on the amount we will accept via PayPal/Credit Card because of the fees associated with the service and due to the potential of charge-backs. In the event that a bidder has a problem with an item listed online, if they use a credit card for payment, their first reaction would be to initiate a charge-back to their credit card. Our experience has shown that the credit card companies will side with the consumer 99% of the time. In the event of a charge-back, unless the City is willing to reimburse its auction company for the charge-back, the auction company would be forced to take a loss on something beyond their control. The City should look very carefully at their responsibility as it relates to charge-backs because many companies that utilize credit cards on a regular basis will (a) have a cap on the amount and (b) require the seller to refund them for any charge-backs. We hope that the City will allow the vendor to accept payments which is in the best interests of both the City and the vendor. We have been collecting on auctions for the past 51 years. The type of payments that we accept ensures that we always collect guaranteed funds for our clients with a minimal risk of charge-backs. We

feel that since we are taking all the risk for the payments that we should be able to determine what type of payments to accept and where to place caps if necessary.

We have a process in place for collecting payments from bidders. In 99% of the cases, our sellers prefer that we collect the proceeds. This keeps them from worrying about the collection of the items and the collection and maintenance of sales tax records. We do this for no additional charges or fees as it is part of our standard service to our clients. A summary of our collection procedure and payment types are discussed below.

All collections for payment are done by Rene' Bates Auctioneers, Inc. Once a successful bidder has been invoiced for their auction purchases, they have four days in which to remit payment to RBAI. Payment is made in the form of cash, cashier's check or money order. Payment can also be made in the form of a wire transfer if the bidder requests that method. We accept PayPal/Credit Cards up to a specified amount as needed. Once payment is received, the bidder and the seller is sent a Paid Receipt from RBAI which the bidder will utilize when picking up their items in accordance with the seller's specific terms and conditions.

After the four days has passed, the staff at RBAI begins contacting all bidders whose payment has not been received. A standard email is sent to the bidder reminding them of when the payment was due as well as a second copy of the invoice sent to them previously. Each communication sent to the bidder has a deadline of when RBAI expects payment. If the deadline passes with no response, we begin with our second email as well as telephone follow-up. We make every effort to collect on all items sold through the online auction.

In the event our collection process is not successful, the bidder will receive a final email notification demanding payment and informing them that their \$100.00 refundable deposit will be forfeited and they will be banned from all future auctions if payment is not received by the designated date.

RBAI will keep the Seller informed of all communications between ourselves and the bidders as it relates to the collections procedure.

Problem Resolution

We are very hands on as it relates to any type of problems or disputes that may arise with our bidder base. In the event that either a bidder or the seller contacts us about a problem with an auction item, we immediately take ownership of the issue. Our first job is to get all the facts from both parties. If it is a situation where a bidder believes they have an issue with an auction item, we determine what the issue is and what resolution the bidder is expecting. From there, we make contact with the seller and verify the information received from the bidder. We look at the bidder's history with us as well as the facts of the issue to come up with a resolution that is acceptable to all parties. We will always verify with the City, if required, before making any decisions that require a refund of any type to a bidder.

Marketing your items to obtain the highest resale

The City's auctions will be published on our website as soon as inventory is available. It will be available for preview before it's open for bidding to ensure that your auction is presented to the public for as long as possible. Your online auction will generally run for a two week period which is what we have found to be the ideal amount of time.

Rene' Bates Auctioneers, Inc. will advertise your auction at our expense through our normal advertising channels at our sole discretion. PLEASE NOTE THAT WE DO NOT DO YOUR LEGAL ADVERTISING. We have the experience and expertise to properly advertise your auction in the most advantageous way to produce exposure and, in turn, generate revenue for your auction.

This is done in order to comply with governmental anti-spam regulations.* We currently average over 30 million hits per month on our website and we are adding email addresses and registered bidders daily due to our continual national and international advertising.

Because we conduct auctions across the United States and are continually adding new locations, the exposure you receive from the new entities buyer's base and our advertising for these new locations will benefit your auction in the increased exposure our website receives.
