TITLE: Motion to Approve the Acceptance of a Donation in the Total Amount of \$63,562.06 from the G. Harold and Margery Martin Fund of the Community Foundation of Broward and Approve a Contract for the Purchase and Installation of Fitness Equipment Station – Greenfields Outdoor Fitness, Inc. - \$63,562.06

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission authorize the City Manager to accept a donation in the total amount of \$63,562.06 from the G. Harold and Margery Martin Fund of the Community Foundation of Broward and approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase and installation of a fitness equipment station for Holiday Park from Greenfields Outdoor Fitness, Inc. (GOF) via the Clay County Contract #13/14-8 in the amount of \$63,562.06.

Background

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting approval to purchase and install a new outdoor fitness station at Holiday Park in an effort to provide fun, safe and accessible fitness for our neighbors and visitors. This fitness station will be funded completely through a donation that was received from the G. Harold and Margery Martin Fund of the Community Foundation of Broward. The fitness station will include wheelchair accessible chest presses, sit-up, pull-up and dip stations, rowing machine, leg press unit and a shade structure.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(f)(5)(b), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the City may piggyback a contract entered into by another governmental or public entity and a provider of supplies or services required by the City. These purchases will be made in accordance with Clay County Contract 13/14-8 from GOF in the amount of \$63,562.06.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$63,562.06 contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 17-1329.
