TITLE: Motion Authorizing Settlement of Workers' Compensation Claim of Steve

Robinson - \$500,000

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the settlement of the workers' compensation claim of Steve Robinson in the amount of \$500,000 and accept reimbursement of the entire amount from the City's excess workers' compensation insurance policy.

## **Background**

Steve Robinson, a Public Works Community Builder, filed a workers' compensation claim for an injury that occurred on November 5, 1998, while in the course and scope of employment with the City.

Through negotiations, a settlement was reached in the amount of \$500,000, subject to the approval of the City Commission. The City will receive reimbursement in the amount of \$500,000 from the excess workers' compensation insurance policy, which provided coverage at the time of the injury. The excess insurance carrier has given the City authority to settle this claim.

## **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact in the amount of \$500,000 to the City, which will subsequently be offset by the insurance reimbursement in the amount of \$500,000.
