TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for the Provident Park Lighting Project – Davco

Electrical Contractors Corp. – \$156,640

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the Provident Park Lighting Project with Davco Electrical Contractors Corp. in the amount of \$156,640.

Background

The work to be accomplished under this contract includes, but is not limited to, the construction and installation of 17 light-emitting diode (LED) energy saving lights at Provident Park. The project scope includes the pole bases, conduits, and wires. Lighting the 1.5 acre park will assist with the overall safety of the park, and will work as a deterrent for unwanted activities. Currently, the park has no lighting.

On August 31, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 473-11980 for this project. The City received three bids in response to the solicitation, which was opened on September 21, 2017. The bid submitted by Davco Electrical Contractors Corp. has met all of the specifications of the solicitation and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bid.

Staff recommends awarding the base bid in the amount of \$146,640. Additionally, a \$10,000 allowance fee is included to cover the costs of construction permit fees. The total price for base plus permit fees is \$156,640.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal year impact to the City in the amount of \$156,640 for the contract award and \$15,664 for estimated in-house project management fees, or a total of \$172,304.
