TITLE: Motion Approving a Revocable License Agreement with Junior League of

Greater Fort Lauderdale. Inc. for the Construction and Installation of a

Statue along Riverwalk

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion to authorize execution of a Revocable License with Junior League of Greater Fort Lauderdale, Inc. for the construction and installation of a statue along Riverwalk.

Background

At the December 5, 2017 Commission Conference meeting, the Junior League of Greater Fort Lauderdale presented a request to install a six-foot aluminum permanent outdoor sculpture along Riverwalk., Exhibit 1, to commemorate their 80th Anniversary. The sculpture is designed by local artist and community leader Leah Brown.

The Junior League of Greater Fort Lauderdale is an organization of women committed to promoting volunteerism, developing the potential of women, and improving the community through effective action and leadership of trained volunteers.

Unveiling of the sculpture is planned for March, 8, 2018. The Junior League of Greater Fort Lauderdale will retain ownership of the statue and will pay all costs associated with installation and on-going maintenance.
