

RESOLUTION NO. 17-284

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTIONS NO. 16-192, 16-206 AND 17-136 TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE INNOVATIVE DEVELOPMENT (ID) DISTRICT ADVISORY COMMITTEE, THE TERMS OF THE ID DISTRICT ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 16-192 adopted November 1, 2016, the City Commission created the Innovative Development (ID) District Advisory Committee, with a termination date of July 12, 2017; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 16-206 adopted November 15, 2016, members were appointed to the ID District Advisory Committee, for one-year terms beginning November 15, 2016 and ending November 14, 2017, or until their successors have been appointed; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 16-206 was amended pursuant to Resolution No. 17-136 adopted July 11, 2017, wherein members were appointed for one-year terms beginning November 15, 2016 and ending January 31, 2018, or until their successors have been appointed; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to extend the term of the ID District Advisory Committee and the terms of the committee members or their successors through July 31, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 6 of Resolution No. 16-192 is hereby amended to read as follows:

That the Innovative Development (ID) District Advisory Committee shall commence on the date this Resolution is adopted and shall terminate on July 31, 2018.

SECTION 2. That all members currently appointed to the Innovative Development (ID) District Advisory Committee shall remain as members until the expiration of their respective terms, or until their successors have been appointed, however, not beyond July 31, 2018, unless further extended by a Resolution adopted by the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and adoption.
