

RESOLUTION NO. 18-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A COMMUNITY AESTHETIC FEATURE AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CITY ENTRYWAY SIGNAGE LOCATED AT ELEVEN CITYWIDE LOCATIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale ("CITY") desires to enter into a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for the non-exclusive access and use of State Highway System right-of-way locations to facilitate construction of CITY entryway welcome signage to be located at eleven (11) citywide locations (hereafter referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the CITY agrees to fund all costs for the design, installation, and maintenance of the Project as further set out in the Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement, in substantially the form attached as Exhibit 1 to Commission Agenda Memorandum No. 18-0039;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission hereby authorizes the proper City officials to enter into a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement, in substantially the form attached as Exhibit 1 to Commission Agenda Memorandum No. 18-0039.

SECTION 2. That the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.
