Waterways Assistance Program Grant - \$8,010.95

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$8,010.95 from the FY2017-2018 Florida Inland Navigation District Waterways Assistance Program Grant on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

**Background**

In March 2017, the City applied to the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) for funding through their FY 2017 Waterways Assistance Grant Program. The grant program provides funding assistance to local governments to perform waterway improvement projects as well as for the purchase of marine law enforcement vessels and related equipment.

The City of Fort Lauderdale submitted a project proposal in the amount of \$16,021.90 for the purchase of one outboard motor to replace an old and malfunctioning engine. Fort Lauderdale was awarded \$8,010.95 in FIND funding towards the purchase of the motor. The City will meet the grant's required 50% cash match by funding the balance of the cost in the amount of \$8,010.95. The grant period is October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2019.

**Resource Impact**

The total project cost is \$16,021.90. There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$8,010.95. There is a negative fiscal cash match impact to the City in the amount of \$8,010.95.
