**TITLE:** Resolution Approving the Execution of the Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement with the State of Florida Department of Transportation for City Entryway Signage Located at Eleven City-wide Locations

---

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the execution of a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement (CAFA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the non-exclusive access and use of State Highway System right-of-way locations to facilitate construction of City Entryway Signage as previously approved by a Consent Motion November 21, 2017, Item CM-6, CAM #17-1244 (Exhibit 2).

**Background**

Commission Agenda Memo #17-1244 was inadvertently submitted and listed on the November 21, 2017 City Commission Agenda as a "Consent Motion" instead of the required "Consent Resolution" and was subsequently approved by the City Commission as a consent motion. FDOT requires approval via a resolution. The proposed resolution is attached as Exhibit 3.

This project is for the construction of entryway signs announcing welcome to Fort Lauderdale. The work includes, but is not limited to, the construction of a breakaway foundation for the signs, fabrication and installation at various locations throughout the City within all four Districts.

The Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement (CAFA) is attached as Exhibit 1.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to the City with this agreement.

**Strategic Connections**

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Public Places Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 3: To invite and welcome our community, domestic and international travelers to Fort Lauderdale.
- Objective 2: To enhance the identity of our City through well maintained medians.
