**TITLE:** Motion to Approve a Three Year Agreement with Heal the Planet  
Together, Inc.

---

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a three year agreement with Heal the Planet Together, Inc., dated February 12, 2018 through December 31, 2020, and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.

**Background**

On September 6, 2017, the City Commission approved a three (3) year agreement with Partners in Action, Inc., d/b/a Kids Ecology Corp., for nature programming at Snyder Park. Kids Ecology Corp has gone out of business and Heal the Planet Together, Inc. would like to take over the same contract. Services offered include children's nature classes and volunteer opportunities for people of all ages to assist with park beautification.

Under the agreement, the instructor is an independent contractor and is not compensated by the City. The instructor is authorized to charge a participant fee for regular public programming, not to exceed \$10.00. If there are supply costs associated with the program offered, program participants will be required to pay for them. At the time the program is scheduled, the instructor will be required to notify the Parks and Recreation Director of program fees and any associated material costs.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

**Strategic Connections:**

This item is a Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018 initiative, included within the Public Places Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 4: Be a community that finds opportunities and leverages partnerships to create unique, inviting, and connected gathering places that highlight our beaches, waterways, urban areas and parks.

- Objective 1: Improve access to and enjoyment of our beach, Riverwalk, waterways, parks and open spaces for everyone.
