## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an assignment of contract for corrosion inhibitor from F2 Industries, LLC to Chemrite, Inc.

## Background

On August 18, 2015, the City Commission approved Contract No. 452-11628 for corrosion inhibitor with F2 Industries, LLC (F2 Industries) for a period of two years with three, one-year renewals in the annual amount of \$66,690 (CAM 15-0928). The contract is currently in the first of three renewals which expires on September 6, 2018.

F2 Industries has been purchased by Chemrite, Inc. (Chemrite). F2 Industries has assigned the contract, in its entirety, to Chemrite. Chemrite shall perform F2 Industries' duties, obligations, and responsibilities under the original contract.
