AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SCHEDULE I OF THE PAY PLAN OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, BY CREATING AND ADDING A DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY CLASS, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That if any clause, section or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning the first full pay period following its final passage.
