TITLE: Resolution Adopting the Fiscal Year 2018 Federal Legislative Priorities

and Funding Requests for the City of Fort Lauderdale

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution formally approving the City of Fort Lauderdale's 2018 Federal Legislative Priorities and Funding Requests.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale has contracted with Alcalde & Fay Ltd, Inc. for federal lobbying service; the firm advocates for the City's interests throughout the year. The attached document articulates the City of Fort Lauderdale's 2018 Federal legislative priorities and funding requests based on the discussion and consensus from the Commission Conference Meeting on February 6, 2018 and incorporating language to endorse legislation that will reduce gun violence based upon a subsequent resolution that the City Commission approved on February 20, 2018.

Through this resolution, the Commission provides direction to the City staff, lobbyists and other interested parties as to the official positon of the City of Fort Lauderdale regarding the issues, pending legislations, and funding requests that would affect the operation of local government. In addition, throughout the upcoming year, staff will seek grant funding for projects and programs that the City Commission has prioritized.
