## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution amending Resolution No. 17-103 by appointing Weiss Serota Helfman Cole & Bierman, P.L., as special counsel for labor and employment matters, prescribing the hourly rates to be paid for such legal services, and authorizing the City Attorney to execute a retainer agreement containing terms acceptable to the City Attorney.

## **Background**

Section 4.10 of the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, provides, in part, that "[t]he city commission may, by resolution, authorize one (1) or more special counsel to be retained for the purpose of performing such legal duties as may be prescribed by said resolution. Each such resolution shall further prescribe the compensation to be paid the special counsel."

The Human Resources Department has requested that the City add Weiss Serota Helfman Cole & Bierman, P.L., to the City's roster of special counsel.
