TITLE:	Application for a Dock Permit for Use by a Private Person, Todd & Karin Correll, on Public Property located at 1735 SE 8 <sup>th</sup> Street

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons, Todd & Karin Correll, of public property located at 1735 SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale, FL.

#### **Background**

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property in accordance with Section 8-144, Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, for the use, maintenance and repair of a proposed new seawall, cap with batter piles, concrete floating marginal dock, a jet dock and a fixed platform with access ramp adjacent to 1735 SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a permit for usage by private persons of public property, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended approval of the application 12 to 0 (see Exhibit 3).
