
Dear Mr. Selznick:

Congratulations! City of Fort Lauderdale (the "Recipient") was selected to receive a Baseball Tomorrow Fund (BTF) grant in conjunction with its participation in the BTF/MLB Equipment Day Program. On behalf of Major League Baseball and the Major League Baseball Players Association, the Baseball Tomorrow Fund is pleased to award a grant in the amount of \$2500. Please note that this grant award expires and will not be disbursed if a signed letter of agreement is not provided to BTF within 30 days.

Specifically, it is understood that:

- 1. This grant is to be used only for the purchase of youth baseball and/or softball equipment and uniforms to support the growth of your program. Grant funds may be used only for bats, balls, helmets, gloves, catcher's equipment and mitts, pitching machines and balls, portable pitching mounds, protective screens, uniform jerseys or tops, uniform pants or shorts, uniform belts, cleats, field maintenance equipment or field maintenance supplies.
- 2. The funds will be administered by the Recipient, under the supervision of Gina Rivera, Grants & Special Projects Coordinator. The Recipient will be responsible for all aspects of the purchases, including without limitation, oversight and administrative responsibilities. Any additional expenditures shall be the sole responsibility of the Recipient. It is understood that the BTF grant in the amount of \$2500 defines the limit of responsibility for BTF. Please find attached information about the BTF Purchasing Program.
- 3. The Recipient will furnish the BTF with a full and complete accounting of funds expended between November 1, 2017 and February 27, 2018 in connection with this grant on or before February 28, 2018. A link to an online report form is attached.

BTF will pay \$2500 within one month of receipt by the BTF of the executed letter of agreement, and the Recipient agrees that the use of grant funds will be completed on or before February 28, 2018. The Recipient agrees that any unexpended grant funds will be returned to the Baseball Tomorrow Fund.
- 5. The Recipient agrees to comply with all applicable guidelines, grant requirements and policies of the BTF, a copy of which is attached.
- 6. The Recipient agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless BTF, its members, employees, officers, and agents from and against any and all claims arising out of or in connection with the purchase and use of equipment, services or supplies and the use of the youth baseball and/or softball programs.
- 7. The Recipient agrees to allow the Baseball Tomorrow Fund use of its name and logo for the purpose of public relations and media materials concerning this grant.
