TITLE Amendment to Ordinance No. C-08-24 - SHIP Affordable Housing Advisory

Committee (AHAC)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an ordinance amending the qualifications for membership on the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC) to comply with State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program changes in accordance with Section 420.9076, Florida Statutes.

Background

The AHAC is a committee appointed by the City Commission for the purpose of recommending specific initiatives and incentives to encourage or facilitate affordable housing. In order to make it easier to recruit AHAC members, the Florida Housing Finance Corporation (FHFC) revised the SHIP Statute for AHAC to include the following changes:

- Members are no longer required to be appointed by resolution.
- The committee should include at least eight members but not more than 11 members.
- The committee must consist of one representative from at least six of the 11 categories.
- Members must be citizens.

The SHIP grant will reimburse the City for eligible activities. The City must submit, triennially, an Affordable Housing Incentive Strategies report created by AHAC as part of the Program funding requirements.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact.
