Fort Lauderdale to Amend the Definition of Holidays as it Relates to Parking

Enforcement

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt an ordinance, on second reading, amending Section 26-1 of the Code of Ordinances amending the definition of holidays related to traffic and parking.

Background

On April 3, 2018, the City Commission heard a proposed ordinance amendment, to change the definition of "Holidays" to correlate with the holidays that City offices are closed for business. The first reading deleted President's Day and Columbus Day and added the day after Thanksgiving in the definitions. It was decided that both President's Day and Columbus Day would remain in the definitions along with the inclusion of the day after Thanksgiving.
