RESOLUTION NO. 18-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, RECOMMENDING THAT THE BROWARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPOINT DEAN J. TRANTALIS, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, TO THE BROWARD COUNTY TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, Section 31½-18 of the Broward County Code provides that the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("County Commission") shall appoint an elected official from the most populous municipality in the county to the Broward County Tourist Development Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale ("City Commission") reached consensus at its March 20, 2018, conference meeting to recommend to the County Commission that Dean J. Trantalis, Mayor of the City of Fort Lauderdale, be appointed to the Broward County Tourist Development Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission hereby recommends that the County Commission appoint Dean J. Trantalis, Mayor of the City of Fort Lauderdale, to the Broward County Tourist Development Council as the elected municipal official from the most populous municipality in the county.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The City Clerk is directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners.
