Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the settlement of the workers' compensation claim of Keith Hudson in the amount of \$186,779.

Background

Keith Hudson, a Parks and Recreation Community Builder, filed a workers' compensation claim for an injury that occurred on May 3, 1995, while in the course and scope of employment with the City.

Through negotiations, a settlement was reached in the amount of \$186,779, subject to the approval of the City Commission.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact in the amount of \$186,779 to the City.
