TITLE: Resolution Regarding the City of Fort Lauderdale's Continued Participation

in the WAVE Streetcar Program

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution regarding the WAVE Streetcar program, per the outcome of the City Commission Workshop of April 30, 2018.

Background

On April 30th, 2018, the City Commission held a Workshop with our other agency partners (Florida Department of Transportation, Broward County, Downtown Development Authority and our Federal Lobbyist) to discuss whether or not the City of Fort Lauderdale will continue to support the Wave Streetcar program.

A "Walk-On" resolution will be submitted after the April 30th Workshop with the direction the City Commission decides to take in response to the discussion at the Workshop.
