TITLE: Motion to Approve Increase in Funds to the Annual Stormwater Construction Contract - Various Contractors – \$2,000,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an increase in funds to the Annual Stormwater Construction Contract No. 473-11907 with Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc., Hinterland Group Inc., GPE Engineering and General Contractor Corp., and DP Development of the Treasure Coast, LLC in the total amount of \$2,000,000.

Background

On June 20, 2017 the City Commission approved the contract award for Stormwater Construction (CAM #17-0642) with Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc., Hinterland Group Inc., GPE Engineering and General Contractor Corp., and DP Development of the Treasure Coast, LLC for the purchase of storm drainage construction services in the estimated aggregate amount of \$4,500,000 for the first two years.

After the implementation of the contract, it was determined that the original cap of \$4,500,000 would be exceeded after the first year and additional funding would be required to fund the contract for the full two-year term. The reasons for the requested increase is the additional workload generated by the stormwater projects listed in the resource impact area as well as the use of contract by other departments and community investment plan (CIP) projects that are fast tracked for completion.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$2,000,000 for this increase. Funds for this contract are available in the FY 2018 Community Investment Plan and FY 2018 Budget in the accounts listed below:
