TITLE: Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Request the Florida Department of Transportation Transfer to Convey Surplus Property to the City of Fort Lauderdale to be Utilized for Public Purpose as Determined by the City

Recommendation

It is recommended the City Commission approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager to request the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to convey surplus property to the City of Fort Lauderdale to be utilized for Public Purpose as determined by the City

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale has interest in acquiring surplus land from FDOT generally located on the west side of A1A and south of NE 9th Street for public purpose use, which consists of a left over section of the AIA right-of-way that dead ends at the Bonnet House property to the south. To review the location map please refer to Exhibit 1.

Should the property be conveyed to the City it will be utilized to maintain the sidewalk area for use by pedestrians along with any other permitted uses associated with such property.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this action.

Strategic Connections

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 1: Be a pedestrian friendly, multi-modal City.
