TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for Holiday Park War Memorial

Auditorium Renovations - Canseco Electrical Contractor, Inc. - \$842,100

<u>Recommendation</u>

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract to Canseco Electrical Contractor, Inc., in substantially the form attached, for renovations including electrical and lighting system replacement at Holiday Park War Memorial Auditorium (WMA) in the amount of \$842,100.

Background

This project is for renovations of War Memorial Auditorium which includes electrical and lighting system replacement including re-wiring and replacement of interior/exterior lighting and security lighting fixtures, backup emergency generator and associated electrical work. In addition, the work includes replacement of the three exterior windows and damaged interior ceiling tiles.

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid Number 12089-183 on January 10, 2018. Four bids were received as part of this solicitation and were opened on February 12, 2018. Canseco Electrical Contractor, Inc. has met all of the specifications of the solicitation and has been deemed to be the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder. Staff recommends awarding the base bid in the amount of \$706,300 plus \$66,300 for exterior lighting replacement (Alternate 1), \$5,000 for windows replacement (Alternate 5), \$5,500 for ceiling tiles replacement (Alternate 6), and \$59,000 for bid allowances, or a total of \$842,100.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$842,100 for the contract award and \$120,000 for estimated project management fees, or a total cost of \$962,100. Funds for this purchase in the amount of \$962,100 are available in the FY 2018 Community Investment Plan (CIP) in the account listed below:
