Background

The Plaintiff, Anthony Stone, et al., filed a Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive relief and for Damages against the City on June 19, 2017.

Through negotiations, a settlement was reached in the amount of \$82,020, subject to the approval of the City Commission.
