RESOLUTION NO. 18-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, TERMINATING AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 14-102; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 14-102, adopted June 17, 2014, the City Commission approved the dedication of certain portions of City-owned lands, as legally described in the Resolution, as public right-of-way to accommodate the needs of the Wave Streetcar operations; and

WHEREAS, the dedication encumbers real property owned by the City and was intended to accommodate ingress and egress for the WAVE Streetcar system; and

WHEREAS, the public right of way has not been improved and is not suitable for vehicular ingress and egress; and

WHEREAS, the City is the fee simple owner of the property adjacent to the dedicated lands described in Resolution No. 14-102; and

WHEREAS, ON May 1, 2018, the City Commission approved termination of the Wave Modern Streetcar Project; and

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2018, the County Commission of Broward County approved termination of the Wave Modern Streetcar Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Resolution No. 14-102 adopted by the City Commission on June 17, 2014 is hereby terminated and rescinded. The designation as a public right of way of the lands described in Resolution No. 14-102 is terminated. Title to the underlying fee of the dedication inures to the City and the City's title is free and clear of this dedication.
