TITLE: Resolution to Rescind and Terminate the Dedication of City-Owned Property
for the Wave Streetcar Project

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution to rescind and terminate the dedication of City-owned property for the Wave Streetcar Project

Background

On June 17, 2014 the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 14-102 declaring the City's intent to dedicate certain portions of City-owned property as public right-of-way to accommodate the needs of the Wave Streetcar operations (Exhibit 2). With City-owned property no longer needed for the Wave Streetcar Project it is in the best public interest that the City rescinds and terminates the dedication.
