TITLE: Ordinance Amending the Noise Ordinance Relating to the Construction of

Large Projects Providing for an Exemption for Time to Comply and to Allow Certain Construction Activity to Occur outside of the Established

Parameters

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt an ordinance to allow certain construction activity to occur outside the parameters established in the current Noise Ordinance.

Background

Pursuant to Section 17-8 of the Code of Ordinances, construction operations are permitted between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Sunday. There are certain construction projects and tasks that are difficult to accomplish within the limited timeframe. One common process, concrete pours, require one long, continuous period that, depending on the size of the project, may take more hours than the Noise Ordinance permits. Once the pour process starts, there can be no break in activity as the concrete must be put in place before it hardens. Often, that process cannot be completed by 7 p.m. The extended hours will also relieve some of the traffic congestion caused by concrete trucks lined up on the street during the day, when traffic is the heaviest.

This ordinance amendment would authorize the City Manager to grant special permits, which provide an exemption from the Noise Ordinance under special circumstances where the absence of an exemption will cause a hardship for the contractor. The permit shall be for a specific period of time and shall include a start date and a finish date. A notice must be posted in at least two places on the perimeter of the construction site during the life of the permit, which is no more than 30 days (with a 15-day extension, if necessary). The City Manager would also have the ability to refer approval of a special permit to the City Commission.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal year 2018 impact associated with this action.
