TITLE: Resolution Approving the Street Name Addition of Dragon Way to that

Section of SW 5th Place between SW 20th Avenue and SW 16th Avenue

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution approving the street name addition of Dragon Way to that section of SW 5th Place between SW 20th Avenue and SW 16th Avenue as illustrated by the location map attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale, with the support of Stranahan High School, is requesting to add the name Dragon Way to that Section of SW 5th Place between SW 20th Avenue and SW 16th Avenue. A letter of support from Stranahan High School is attached as (Exhibit 2). .

Upon City Commission approval, Broward County Traffic Engineering Division (BCTED) will install the street name signs reflecting the street name addition (Exhibit 3). The primary street name will be Dragon Way and SW 5th Place will be displayed as the secondary street name. The Neighbor Support Division of the City Manager's Office has agreed to fund all costs associated with the fabrication and installation of the street name addition. Typically, it has taken BCTED approximately four to six weeks to have new street signs fabricated and installed after receiving the City's resolution.

This action further directs staff to submit a request to BCTED to implement the necessary street name change on the affected roadway segment.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the anticipated amount of \$500.00, associated with the fabrication and installation of the street name addition.
