

FIRST AMENDMENT TO RECIPROCAL USE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA
AND
THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE RECIPROCAL USE AGREEMENT (the "FIRST AMENDMENT") IS MADE AND ENTERED INTO THIS _____ DAY of _____, 20__ BY AND BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "SBBC" AND THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "CITY."

WHEREAS, SBBC and CITY entered into a Reciprocal Use Agreement ("Agreement") commencing on June 21, 2016;

WHEREAS, **Exhibit A** of the Agreement states that other CITY owned facilities within the corporate limits of the CITY may be added by mutual agreement of the Superintendent of Schools (or designee) and the CITY Manager (or designee) and without formal amendment of the Agreement;

WHEREAS, SBBC and CITY desire to add one facility to the list of facilities outlined in **Exhibit A** of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, SBBC and CITY desire to enter into this Informal First Amendment to Reciprocal Use Agreement to memorialize the amendment of **Exhibit A** to the Agreement to include one additional facility.


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions, promises, covenants, and payments, hereinafter set forth, SBBC and CITY hereby agree as follows:

1. Each and every WHEREAS clause set forth above is a true and correct recital and representation, and is incorporated herein as if set forth in full.
2. **Exhibit A** to the Agreement shall be amended to include South Side Cultural Arts Center. *A copy of the First Amended Exhibit A* is attached and incorporated as First Amended **Exhibit A**.
3. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
